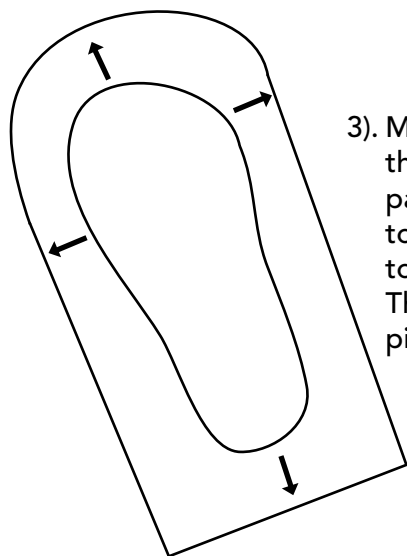
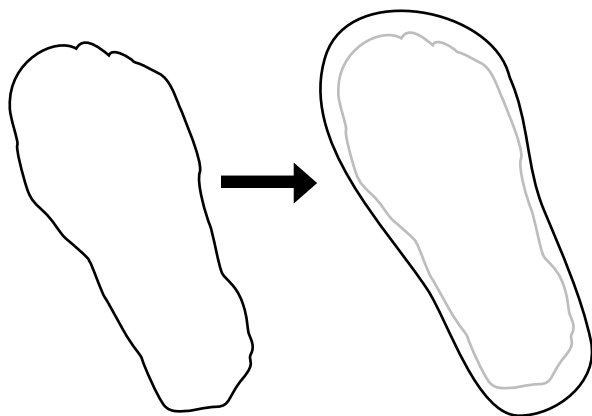


1). Trace around each foot, holding the pen or pencil at a 90 degree angle to the piece of paper.

2). Draw around the outlines you just made to create a smooth outline of your foot, making sure to enlarge 1/4" for a seam allowance. This is your pattern for the sole (bottom of the slipper). Cut two of these from your sweater and one from the batting. Make sure you do this for each foot separately!



3). Measure 5/8" out from the highest part of the toe, bottom of the heel, and widest part across your toes. Use these as a guide to re-draw your foot silhouette around the toe portion, ending in a box at the bottom. This is the beginning of your top pattern piece.

4). Draw lines on the top piece, dividing it into thirds. Trace over the two vertical lines up the center until you reach the top third, finishing with a half-circle. Then cut one of each piece per foot.
