

# EASY, ECLECTIC ENVELOPES

Let your envelopes be just as gorgeous as the cards they carry. Minimal materials and an easy-to-follow template make constructing these envelopes super simple.

## MATERIALS

Paper  
Scissors  
Glue stick  
Envelope template (see page 2)  
Ballpoint pen

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using a glue stick, fasten several selected paper pieces together to create a single sheet at least 7.5" x 9" in size.

**Tip:** Before you begin folding your envelope, trim a piece of paper in a complementary color to the size of the template. Adhere it to the interior side of the envelope with your glue stick. Once constructed, the accent paper will add a bold surprise of color when the flap is opened.

2. Print out your envelope template, then use a ballpoint pen to trace the template onto your sheet.
3. Use your fingernail to make a sharp, clean crease and fold in side flaps A and B.
4. Apply your glue stick to the tops of sections A and B, then fold section C up and over, pressing firmly to seal in place.
5. Fill your envelope with its contents, then use your glue stick to seal the remaining top flap in place.
